**Subject: Adams Compressor Station Municipal Notification of GP-5 General Permit Application Modification
Mountain Gathering, LLC**

Dear Ms. Revak and Mr. Tabaj:

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that TITAN Engineering, Inc. (TITAN), a Division of APEX Companies, LLC, on behalf of Mountain Gathering, LLC, has submitted a revised Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) GP-5 General Permit Application for the Adams Compressor Station to Region 5.


The Adams Compressor Station uses natural gas fired compressor engines to gather natural gas from wells and sells the gas into a higher pressure market through a custody transfer point (sales meter).

The GP-5 General Permit Application includes these sources: three (3) natural gas compressor engines, a dehydration unit and associated reboiler, thirty (30) wells within a mile radius of the site, thirty-one (31) produced water tanks, three (3) waste oil tanks, a loading rack and associated site and well pad piping fugitives. The proposed revision will include the replacement of one (1) natural gas compressor engine and one (1) dehydration unit reboiler.

Please note there is a 30-day comment period which begins upon receipt of this notice.
